# TAROT

**JEAN-MICHEL DAVID**

### What is this course about?

The focus of the course will be through the 1650 Noblet Marseille-type Tarot deck designed in Paris. It is around this time, and from this style, that later tarot emerges. An understanding of the Marseille style deck provides for a firm and general foundation in tarot, and an understanding as to the most important influence in deck imagery.

Having said this, the course is all about Tarot – in its variety, its development over the centuries, and its contemporary uses.

Over the course of 30 weeks, we'll be looking at tarot's structure, its history, and its symbolic detail, whilst at the same time developing skills in using it to aid reflection, to provide the basis for interpretation, and to become an aid in one's own varied spiritual journey.

There is no question that tarot emerges in an environment rich with Christian iconography, that is itself rooted in the cultural soils of Ancient Egypt, Ancient Greece and the Roman Empire. Some of these foundations will make for important reflective incursions during the course.

The first session will provide an overview of tarot in terms of its structure and its development over time. Most subsequent weeks will focus on individual cards – mainly the trumps – or groups of cards, such as the pips and courts. This may at times lead us far afield from the world of tarot proper, bringing to discussion legends, stories and imagery from various parts of the world, as well as bringing to focus the depicted implements, number symbolism and human temperaments.

Each week, we'll also have some time for quiet reflection or drawing; some time put aside to develop our narrative skills using tarot for readings; and a focussed presentation on the topic at hand.

### You will need:

- a copy of the common deck (*Noblet Marseille*) available through the *Association for Tarot Studies*;
- in addition, you may also bring any other tarot deck(s) of your choice;
- writing materials (including some colouring pencils) and notebook – this will be used for both notetaking you may wish to make *as well as for sketches* that forms part of the course.

### About Jean-Michel David

Jean-Michel has taught Tarot courses over varying duration since the late 1980s. He was the principal organiser and a presenter at the 2005 International Tarot Conference, a founder of the *Association for Tarot Studies*, main instigator of *Tarotpedia*. He is also amongst a small number of researchers listed on the *Who's Who* of Tarot on the German based Trionfi.com.

Jean-Michel's publication involvement include Robert O'Neill's and Frank Jensen's tarot books; the *Journal Taros*; and the *ATS Newsletter*. He was also responsible for overseeing the 2007 winner of the *International Tarot Award* (awarded to Mary Greer).

Jean-Michel's tarot book, *Reading the Marseille Tarot*, has been described as a 'rare treasure' amidst the thousands of available books on tarot.

In addition, Jean-Michel has also featured on ABC's *Radio National with Rachel Kohn*.
